Each year the SHCT will award ONE scholarship to an individual with hearing impairment enrolling in full-time study or training, including vocational training. The value of this scholarship will be \$5,000.

Priority will be given to cochlear implant recipients, but the scholarship is also open to those with permanent hearing impairment who use hearing aids.

Applications will only be accepted from those residing in the catchment area of the Southern Cochlear Implant Programme.

Applications should be made no later than **31 October** in any year.
